Dear Parents,

We have been notified by the State Department of Health and Senior Services of the following Information:

“In the 2010 -2011 school year, all pupils aged 6-59 months must receive one dose of the flu vaccine by December 31st. Pupils who are not in compliance by this due date must be excluded from school for the duration of influenza season (through March 31st) or until they receive at least one dose of the influenza vaccine.”

“All pupils in licensed childcare or preschool facilities are required to receive age appropriate doses of pneumococcal vaccine. Pupils 12-59 months of age will be required to receive a minimum of one dose on or after their first birthday.”

What does this mean for our Turtle Creek Students? All children are required to get the flu vaccine by December 31, 2010. Students who have not received the vaccine by this date will not be allowed to return to school until after the flu season, March 31st. In addition, all of our students are required by the state to have received at least one dose of the pneumococcal vaccine.
